Volunteer Opportunities

March 2- March 9, 2025 - La Paloma Country Club

Admissions/ Will Call

Assist with admission and main gate entrance. Check for proper credentials and provide general information. Assist with Will Call ticket pick up and drop offs. Days of Operation: Friday – Sunday.

Caddy Services

Assist with Professional Caddie registration and services throughout tournament week. Distribute/wash/collect towels and bibs, maintain the caddie lounge area and act as a concierge. Days of Operation: Monday – Sunday.

Hospitality

Greet guests and confirm properly credentialed clients are allowed in private hospitality areas. Assist Marshal Committee with noise control when players approach hospitality areas. Days of Operation: Friday-Sunday .

Volunteer Headquarters

Responsible for the operation and management of Volunteer Headquarters during tournament week (exclusive use of credentialed volunteers). Assist with food and beverages; check-in and maintaining a clean environment. Days of Operation: Monday – Sunday.

Marshals

Provide gallery noise control, assist in player movement, help locate errant golf shots and provide spectators with general information. Also assist with the player movement on and off the course due to weather delays or whenever deemed necessary. Days of Operation: Wednesday-Sunday.

Shuttle Services

Assist with golf carts as they are used for shuttles and transportation on course. Responsible for transporting walking scorers, standard bearers, players and caddies to/from specific areas determined and approved by rules committee. Days of Operation: Friday-Sunday.

Standard Bearer

Accompany each group of professionals during play and display their scores on a standard sign. Must be able to carry a standard sign (approx. 7 lbs.) and walk 18 holes without a break. Dates of Operation: Wednesday – Sunday.

Supply and Distribution

Inventory, distribute and maintain tournament supplies such as ice, coolers, drinks, pairings sheets and programs to designated areas. Committee requires a significant amount of lifting. 1.Days of Operation: Monday – Sunday.

Walking Scorers

Record statistics and scores of players on a Palm Pilot during competition rounds and must be able to walk 18 holes. Walking Scorers will be asked to attend a MANDATORY training session prior to the tournament. Days of Operation: Wednesday - Sunday

Transportation

Provide transportation to professionals and VIP guests before, during and after the tournament. Drivers must be at least 25 years old and provide a valid driver's license issued by the volunteer's jurisdiction of residency. Days of Operation: Saturday, March 1- Monday, March 10.

Long Drive

Assist with Professional Caddie registration and services throughout tournament week. Distribute/wash/collect towels and bibs, maintain the caddie lounge area and act as a concierge. Days of Operation: Monday – Sunday.

Cart Barn

Assist with cart distribution and maintenance including managing cart list, washing, towing and charging. Committee requires a significant amount of lifting and the possibility to be standing for extended periods of time. Days of Operation: Sunday-Sunday.
